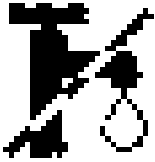


Climbador Clematis



A must have vine in the garden for beginner gardeners. Westphal, Germany, 1982. Clematis Konigskind(tm) (or Climador) is a wonderfully compact seedling of Clematis The President. It's short stature and upward-facing 5 inch flowers make it excellent grown in a container on your patio or deck.

Clematis 'Climbador'

- **Use:** "Queen of the climbers." Clematis are prized for their incredible flowers, most as large as your hand. Will train onto trellises, fences, or arch over doorways. Stunning when used alone or when several colors are mixed. Plant this Clematis to cover fence lines or on a trellis on a sunny open wall on your house. Just make sure it's roots are in a fairly cool and shaded location. This cultivar is very free flowering and a big favorite of many of our gardeners.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun–shade (not deep shade); Water regularly, when top 3" of soil is dry. Prefers to have its roots shaded and its flowers in the sun. Use slow release fertilizer twice a year. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Twining stems reach 3 to 5 ft. tall, 3 to 4 ft. wide, with support. Pruning Type 2 Blooms on new and old growth. Should not require major pruning. Pruning can be used to keep the vines growth in check and to remove any dead or weak growth. This should be done after the early blooming period. The old seed heads from the early blooms should be removed. This will help to maximize blooming later on in the year.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial, Vine
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Delicate green foliage grows quickly.
- **Flowers:** A continuous profusion of large, vivacious, violet-blue flowers with deep burgundy-tipped anthers on a compact vine that is perfect for making a grand statement in a small garden.
