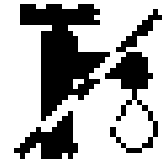


Fireworks Clematis



Clematis 'Fireworks'

Tough vine that bursts forth with showy flowers from delicate foliage! 'Fireworks' was Awarded Royal Horticultural Society's Award of Merit.

- **Use:** "Queen of the climbers." Clematis are prized for their incredible flowers, most as large as your hand. Will train onto trellises, fences, or arch over doorways. Only needs to have its roots shaded and its flowers in the sun. This specimen works well planted in the border, grown over a shrub, or trained over a trellis or pergola. This Clematis is suitable for growing in shaded areas.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun–part shade (not deep shade); Water regularly, when top 3" of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer twice a year. Once established needs only occasional water. Be careful not to overwater a newly planted clematis. Group 2 – Flowers on both old and new wood. Typically, little pruning should be done for woody-stemmed members of this Group. If cut to the ground or pruned in fall or spring, flowering will be reduced or delayed but not prevented.
- **Growth:** This vigorous, pure white variety grows to 12'.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Perennial, Vine
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Trifoliate green foliage.
- **Flowers:** Large, bi-color flowers (7-8" in diameter). Each petal features a wide, deep pink stripe from tip to base that is edged with mauve. Blooms from late spring to early summer, with an additional but smaller late summer to early fall bloom occurring on new growth.
