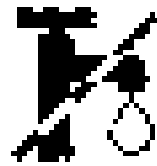


# Ramona Clematis



## *Clematis 'Ramona'*

**A vigorous, large-flowered clematis with lovely periwinkle blue blossoms that measure up to 7" across. Ramona is a tried and true performer that's been consistently popular since the 1800s. It flowers in early summer and often blooms again in early fall.**



- **Use:** "Queen of the climbers." Clematis are prized for their incredible flowers, most as large as your hand. Will train onto trellises, fences, or arch over doorways. Only needs to have its roots shaded and its flowers in the sun. This specimen works well planted in the border, grown over a shrub, or trained over a trellis or pergola.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun–shade (not deep shade); Water regularly, when top 3" of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer twice a year. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Fast grower to 3-5 feet long. Pruning group 2, which means the clematis vine blooms on old and new wood and re-blooms all summer! So prune the stems in late winter or early spring.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Perennial, Vine
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Delicate green leaves.
- **Flowers:** Lavender-blue flowers with dark anthers. Blooms July, August and September.
