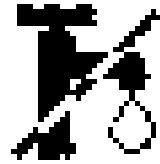


Sano No Mirasaki Clematis



Tough vine that bursts forth with showy flowers from delicate foliage!



Clematis 'Sano No Mirasaki'

- **Use:** “Queen of the climbers.” Clematis are prized for their incredible flowers, most as large as your hand. Will train onto trellises, fences, or arch over doorways. Only needs to have its roots shaded and its flowers in the sun. This specimen works well planted in the border, grown over a shrub, or trained over a trellis or pergola. This Clematis is suitable for growing in shaded areas.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun–shade (not deep shade); Water regularly, when top 3” of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer twice a year. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 3 to 5 feet long. Dwarf habit is ideal for containers. Some say it should be in pruning group 1 but sources in Oregon contend that it is: Pruning 3. Just cut it back near the ground in winter and it happily springs back every year for another show.
- **Hardiness:** 3-9; Perennial, Vine
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Delicate green leaves.
- **Flowers:** Medium velvet purple flowers with a red purple bar. Red-purple or brown anthers. The name means 'Sano violet'
