

Sarah Elizabeth Clematis



It's a free-flowering variety that's bushy and lush, yet bred for its compact habit. If you're a fan of Clematis blooms but lack the room for a long vine toppling over fences and crawling up walls, these pretty, understated blooms are ideal for growing in containers.

Clematis 'Sarah Elizabeth'

- **Use:** This distinct, attractive pink clematis almost seems to glow. The mass of flower appear from late spring until late Autumn. It produces flowers at the base of the plant and on new growth often producing a top to bottom flowering effect. It grows 4-5' and can be grown in full sun or partial shade.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun–shade (not deep shade); Water regularly, when top 3" of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer twice a year. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Grows to 4 to 5 ft. tall and wide; taller if trained as a climber. Reduce all stems down to 6" (15cm) late winter/early Spring.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-10; Perennial, Vine/ Groundcover
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Delicate green leaves.
- **Flowers:** The bubblegum-pink color of each bloom is simply outstanding, and they'll keep flowering all through summer.
