

# Sugar Candy Evione Clematis



**Tough vine that bursts forth with showy flowers from delicate foliage!**



## ***Clematis 'Sugar Candy Evione'***

- **Use:** "Queen of the climbers." Clematis are prized for their incredible flowers, most as large as your hand. Will train onto trellises, fences, or arch over doorways. Only prefers to have its roots shaded and its flowers in the sun. This specimen works well planted in the border, grown over a shrub, or trained over a trellis or pergola. This Clematis is suitable for growing in shaded areas.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun–shade (not deep shade); Water regularly, when top 3" of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer twice a year. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Fast grower to 8 to 12 feet long. Pruning type 3: Just cut it back near the ground in winter and it happily springs back every year for another show. Pruning Type 2- In this group all first flowering comes from last season's ripened stems. In early Spring watch for swelling leaf buds beginning to show. Cut all dead material off above these swelling buds. Be sure all growth is tied to trellis at this time. Do not tie too tightly, so growth can begin and not hampered by tying too tight or cracking these stems.
- **Hardiness:** 3-9; Perennial, Vine
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Delicate green leaves.
- **Flowers:** A striking cultivar which is free flowering both in the spring and late summer. Large 6-7" flowers with pinkish mauve pointed petals which have a darker center bar. Contrasting yellow anthers with pinkish gray filaments. Blooms May-September.
