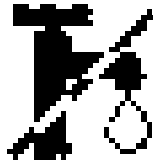


Sunset Clematis



Tough vine that bursts forth with showy flowers from delicate foliage!



Clematis 'Sunset'

- **Use:** “Queen of the climbers.” Clematis are prized for their incredible flowers, most as large as your hand. Will train onto trellises, fences, or arch over doorways. Only needs to have its roots shaded and its flowers in the sun. Stunning when used alone or when several colors are mixed. Also can be used in containers. This specimen works well planted in the border, grown over a shrub, or trained over a trellis or pergola. This Clematis is suitable for growing in shaded areas, but better blooms in full sun.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun–shade (not deep shade); Water regularly, when top 3” of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer twice a year. Once established needs only occasional water. What's surprising for a yellow pruning group Clematis is that Sunset blooms beautifully on old and new vines, so don't dismay if winter winds wreaked some havoc, there's plenty of beauty to come with this one.
- **Growth:** Fast grower to 5 to 9 feet long.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial, Vine
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Delicate foliage quickly springs to life and quickly covers a fence or trellis.
- **Flowers:** Sunset has those tropical hues you'd expect to find in a fruity blended drink at a beach bar. Those colors in perfect contrast are displayed on large, outward-facing, disc-shaped blooms, showing what the ideal color contrast and form can do for a flower. Large flowers take up room on the medium plant, and dress up your perennial border, on a trellis. Sunset also looks lovely on a pergola or arch, and as it climbs up above your garden beds, it'll bring that summer cocktail look to your landscape.
