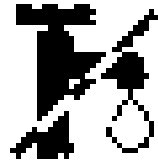


Clematis Rubens Montana



Wonderful in early spring when it is covered with masses of pure white anemone-like single flowers with a sweet fragrance. Easily climbs to 30 ft.. Prune to rejuvenate or control size immediately after bloom. Will grow in full sun to some shade with moderate to occasional water. Generally deer resistant.



Clematis montana 'Grandiflora'

- **Use:** "Queen of the climbers." Clematis are prized for their incredible flowers, most as large as your hand. Will train onto trellises, fences, or arch over doorways. Only needs to have its roots shaded and its flowers in the sun. This specimen works well trained over a trellis or pergola. This Clematis is suitable for growing in shaded areas.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun–shade (not deep shade); Water regularly, when top 3" of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer twice a year. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Fast grower to 20 to 30 feet long. A type 1 Clematis. Clematis in this group are early season bloomers and flower from buds developed on the growth made the previous year. They should be pruned right after flowering to remove the dead foliage. Do not prune late in the season.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Perennial, Vine
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Delicate green leaves.
- **Flowers:** 3" pure white flowers with very wide petals. Vanilla fragrance at times. Montana Clematis varieties are probably the easiest to grow, very prolific blooming and some of the most vigorous growers.
