## *Jasminum polyanthum*

- **Use:** Fast-growing evergreen vine prized for its spectacular display of intensely fragrant pinkish-white flowers. Use as a climber over trellis or arbor, ground cover or in containers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Water when top 3” of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Fast-growing vine or climber, to 20 ft
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8-11, Tender Vine/Houseplant. If bought in colder months enjoy fragrance indoors and wait until after last frost in late April before planting outdoors. Do not cut back stems until after late April if pruning in subsequent years.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous/Semi-Evergreen. Slender green leaves are in pairs of 5-7 pointed leaflets.
- **Flower:** Flowers are star-shaped, white, rose on the outside, borne in dense clusters, very fragrant; flower buds delicate, pink, long, pointed; blooms heaviest in late-winter. Rarely produces black fruit.
