

# Peaches & Cream Honeysuckle



At last a civilized Honeysuckle, compact enough to give you summer-long color on a lamp post or mailbox.

*Lonicera periclymenum 'Inov86'* PP 21,839

- **Use:** Easy care once established, and mildew resistant. Tolerates a wide range of conditions, is long flowering, attracts hummingbirds and butterflies, and when grown on a trellis or arbor, the round, blue-green foliage adds height to the garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** Fast-growing vine to 5ft+. Can also be pruned back to form a dense shrub 4 to 6 feet round.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial Vine or Shrub
- **Foliage:** Semi-deciduous. Bluish green foliage.
- **Flower:** This deliciously fragrant, bicolor French hybrid has purple buds and huge, dark pink-and-white florets maturing to peachy cream. Blooms non-stop from spring through late summer!
