- **Use:** For sheer beauty, this flowering vine is hard to beat. Mexican Flame Vine is a great fast-growing everbloomer and butterfly attractor. The plant is good for beginners since it is drought resistant and hardly bothered by any pests. Minimum care is rewarded with impressive floral displays. It is a vigorous climber with thick evergreen leaves which deep green color provides a rich background for brilliant bright orange daisy-like flowers, borne in clusters.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Light shade best. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. In hot summer needs lots of water.
- **Growth:** Fast grower to 20 ft. long.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11, Annual/ possibly a tender perennial; Needs winter protection
- **Foliage:** Deciduous-semi-evergreen; Dark green, glossy leaves are toothed on the margins and are very handsome.
- **Flower:** Vivid orange daisy flowers with centers of gold grace this twining vine. The 2" wide flowers bloom from late spring to fall.
