

Madison Star/ Confederate Jasmine



Trachelospermum jasminoides 'Madison'

- **Use:** A slightly more cold hardy form of the popular vining or spreading vine. Beautiful evergreen vine prized for its very fragrant, star-shaped white flowers. Train on posts, walls, or trellises, or use as a fast-growing shrubby ground cover. Can also be grown in a container.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water when top 3 in of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Vine with 18 to 20 feet twining branches 1 to 2 feet tall.
- **Hardiness:** 7-9; Shrub / Vine
- **Foliage:** Glossy evergreen leaves.
- **Flowers:** Fragrant blossoms in the summer.
