

# Variegated Star/ Confederate Jasmine



## *Trachelospermum jasminoides*

- **Use:** Beautiful evergreen vine prized for its very fragrant, star-shaped white flowers. Train on posts, walls, or trellises, or use as a fast-growing shrubby ground cover. Can also be grown in a container.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water when top 3 in of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Vine with 18 to 20 feet twining branches 1 to 2 feet tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-9; Groundcover Shrub / Vine
- **Foliage:** Thick, round evergreen leaves, edged and blotched with white
- **Flowers:** Its fragrant white blooms perfume the garden in summer, though the flowers are far less conspicuous against the lighter variegated foliage than on the standard Star Jasmine

Fragrant and deer resistant! As a spreading vine it performs well in mixed borders and as a formal or informal groundcover.
