

Snow Showers Wisteria



Has lime-green foliage and produces fragrant, pure white flowers in spring and through into summer.

Wisteria floribunda 'Snow Showers' (Shiro Noda)

- **Use:** Espalier onto trellis, arbor and over gateways. Perfect to run across the top of wall or fence without engulfing it
- **Exposure:** Full sun to part shade with fertile well drained soil with moderate moisture. Best flowers in the full sun
- **Growth:** Depends on desired form. If left to its own devices, wisteria will grow into a 20-30' vine. Can be grown along fences, up pergolas and trellises. Structures must be strong to support weight of mature plants. Size can be greatly restrained and flowering increased by summer pruning. Can be grown as a 'tree' form standard.
- **Hardiness: Zone 6-9; Vine**
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. May be pruned back heavily in winter as it flowers on new growth.
- **Flower:** Has clusters up to 18 inches long, closely packed with pure white, lightly fragrant blossoms.
